EVENT – Introduction and Knowledge Check



EVENT Description:

- Instructor introduces Executive Function and Executive Functioning Skills.
- Instructor gives a “quiz” to teachers to record their knowledge of identifying Executive Functioning Skills.
- Instructor gives a presentation on Executive Functioning Skills.
- Instructor leads teachers in a debrief on Executive Functioning Skills.

EVENT Deliverables:

- Teachers will demonstrate they understand the characteristics of Executive Functioning Skills.
- Teachers will be able to clearly identify Executive Functioning Skills that are needed for project development and completion.

EVENT-required resources:

- Pre-built online interactive application to measure teachers’ knowledge of EF skills.
- Media for presentation on EF skills.
- Individual Laptops.
- Personal cell phones.

Clarifying Notes on EVENT:

- Gauging teacher level of understanding of EF skills is important for use of the EF skill evaluation tool and planning support for student EF skill development.
