EVENT – Building Shared Tools



EVENT Description:

- Teachers are given an assessment that requires them to match tools (Cognitive Strategies) students can use to support specific EF Skills.
- Teachers work in their groups to create a tool for a specific EF Skill that can be shared schoolwide.

EVENT Deliverables:

- Teachers will demonstrate they understand which tools (calendar, listing tasks, mind map, etc.) can be used to support a student's EF Skills by completing an online assessment.
- Teachers will create an EF Skill tool to share on a cloud-based platform to share schoolwide.
